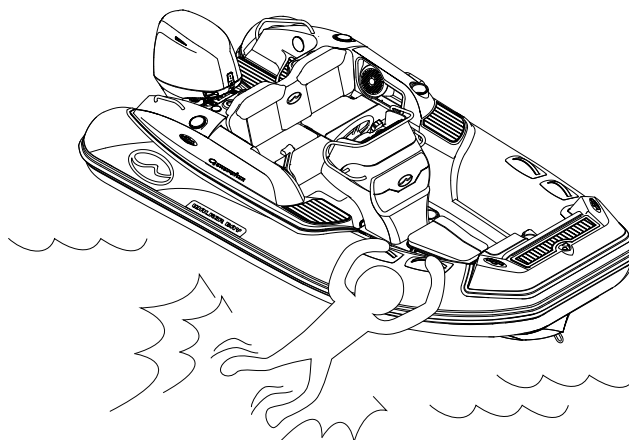
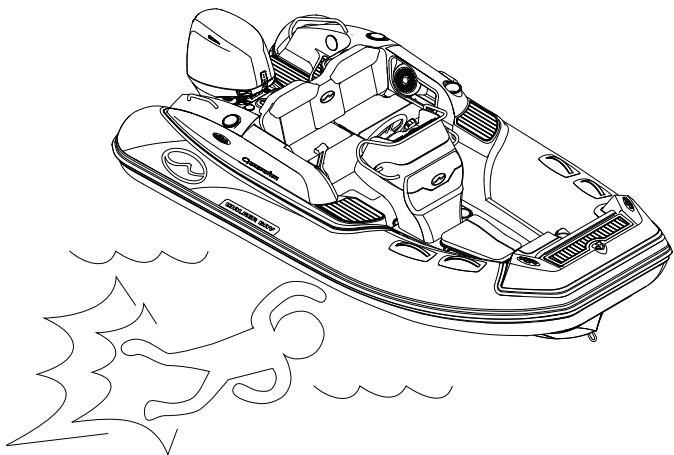


WALKER BAY

In the event a passenger falls overboard, there are several ways to re-board a Walker Bay boat from the water.

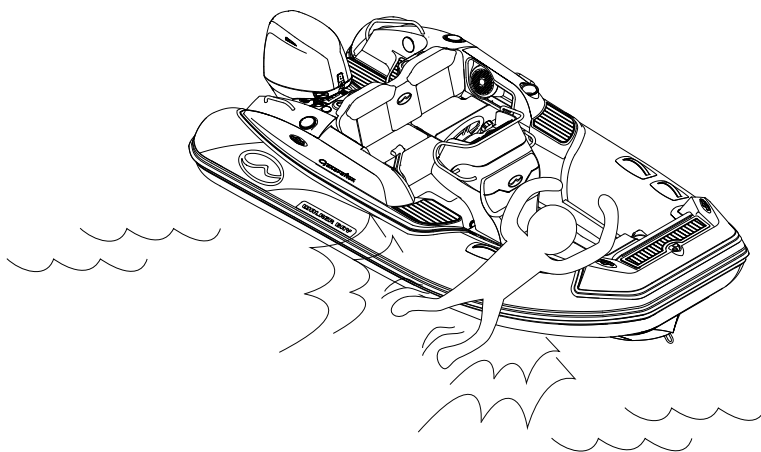
The Generation 12 model can be equipped with a ladder to facilitate re-boarding, however depending on the configuration of the boat they may or may not have a ladder for re-boarding, the re-boarding procedure without a ladder is described below:

- ① Swim to the starboard side of your boat.



- ② Grab the handles that are located on the top of the inflatable tube.

- ③ Hold your breath and contract, then kick down hard so that your body is pushed up and your abdomen rests on the tube.

- ④ With then your abdomen resting on the tube grab and hold on the edge of the seat and pull at the same time kick so that your body slides over the tube until you reach the handles on the other side and pull them to get on the boat.
