1. Nature and extent of warranty. Walker Bay Boats, Inc. ("Manufacturer") warrants to the original retail purchaser ("purchaser") that any Walker Bay boat or accessory ("product") purchased by buyer from manufacturer shall be free from defects in workmanship and/or materials for a period of one (1) year after the date of original retail purchase. In the event of such a defect, manufacturer will, at its option, repair or replace the defective product or part thereof without charge (excluding shipping costs). The original receipt of purchase will be required upon submission of a warranty claim and must clearly detail

the date of purchase, the store where it was purchased, the product that was purchased and the sales receipt number. Photos may also be required.

2. Extended warranty.

2.1. Hull. A purchaser who returns the boat owner registration card, or registers their boat online within 30 days of the date of purchase will be entitled to an additional nine (9) years, for a total of ten (10) years, of coverage under this warranty for the hull.

2.2. Rigid Inflatable Dinghy (RID) tube. A purchaser of a Walker Bay Rigid Inflatable Dinghy who registers their boat online within 30 days of the date of purchase will be entitled to:

2.2.1. An additional four (4) years, for a total of five (5) years, of coverage under this warranty for the buoyancy tube material of a PVC RID tube.

3. Exclusions. This warranty does not cover:

3.1. In the case of the boat: normal color fading.

3.2. In the case of the Rigid Inflatable Dinghy tube:

3.2.1. Normal discoloration, dulling, or crazing of the fabric;

3.2.2. Abrasions, tears, or punctures;

3.2.3. Damage to or deterioration of the fabric due to U.V. exposure;

3.2.4. Damage or deterioration of the fabric due to exposure to fuel, harsh solvents, or other chemicals; or

3.2.5. Seam separation due to heat exposure.

3.3. Buoyancy tube seams, except that manufacturer warrants only that the buoyancy tube seams will maintain air holding integrity equal to international standard organization's (ISO), standard # 6185. See Owner's Manual for care directions.

3.4. Any product that

3.4.1. Has not been assembled, used, and maintained in accordance with the Instructions or Owner's Manual accompanying the product;

3.4.2. Has been damaged in an accident;

3.4.3. Has been abused, misused or improperly operated;

3.4.4. Has been repaired, modified or tampered with by someone other than manufacturer, or authorized depot; or



3.5. Shipping costs. All shipping expenses related to a warranty claim are the purchaser's responsibility.

4. If any product is purchased or used for rental or other commercial purposes, or for/by a corporation, partnership, company, organization or association including without limitation camps, clubs, resorts, schools, or the like, then the term of this limited warranty is limited to a period of ninety (90) days after the date of original retail purchase, and sections 2 (extended warranty) shall not apply.

5. To obtain warranty service for any product covered by this limited warranty, purchaser must contact the dealer from which the product was purchased, together with satisfactory proof of the date and place of purchase, to report the warranty claim.

Upon presentation of the product and satisfactory proof of purchase, the dealer will promptly notify manufacturer of the nature and claimed defect in the product and request a disposition of the warranty claim in conformity with this limited warranty.

If manufacturer determines that a defect exists, purchaser will be advised by manufacturer whether the defective product or part thereof will be repaired in the field or must be shipped by purchaser to manufacturer for repair or replacement, at manufacturer's discretion. All shipping expenses are the purchaser's responsibility. Name and address of the nearest Walker Bay Boats dealer can be obtained from manufacturer.

6. Manufacturer's sole obligation, and buyer's sole and exclusive remedy, under this warranty shall be the repair or replacement, at manufacturer's option and subject to the terms and conditions of this warranty, of any part or parts which are determined by manufacturer to be defective. Without limiting the foregoing, under no circumstances shall manufacturer be liable for any incidental, special, consequential, contingent, or punitive damages, for any breach of warranty.

7. Limitation and disclaimer of warranty. Except as herein above set forth, manufacturer makes no warranty of any kind, express or implied, and the limited warranty hereinabove set forth is expressly in lieu of any warranties and representations, express or implied, and all other obligations or liabilities on the part of manufacturer. If, without limiting and notwithstanding the foregoing, any warranty shall be found to exist beyond the limited warranty hereinabove set forth, any such additional warranty shall be limited in duration to the term of the repair or replacement warranty provided for herein without application of section 2 (extended warranty).

8. Limitations of remedies. Water activities are, by their nature, hazardous. Users of manufacturer's products assume all risk and liability whatsoever resulting directly or indirectly from the use of such products, whether used singularly or in combination with other equipment, including all risk of bodily injury or death and whether arising in contract or tort or otherwise, and specifically including incidental, special, and consequential damages. Remedies for breach of contract arising by implication or operation of law, except as otherwise provided herein, are excluded. Your boat should only be operated within the U.S. Coast Guard approved maximum capacity ratings as stated on the boat.

9. Restrictions on limitations and disclaimers. Some states may not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, or the exclusion or limitation of the duration of implied warranties. Therefore, some or all of the limitations and/or exclusions of warranties and remedies set forth above may not apply to you. This warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights, which vary, from state to state.

10. Warranty registration form. In order to obtain your extended warranty (as described in section 2 above), submit the Owner's Registration Card (form can also be submitted from our website: [www.walkerbay.com](http://www.walkerbay.com)). This information will also provide the manufacturer with a way to contact you, should communications regarding its products be necessary. Manufacturer is not responsible for lost or misdirected mail and/or illegible registrations.

11. Severability. If any provision of this limited warranty is unenforceable, for any reason, all other provisions hereof shall remain in full force and effect.



**12. Maintenance and storage.**

12.1. Hull and seats. Under no circumstances should any part of the boat, specifically including the bottom thereof, be waxed or painted or cleaned with solvents. A mild detergent and tap water should be used to clean the boat. Do not store or handle the boat in extremely cold temperatures. Bright colors may fade when exposed to sunlight for prolonged periods.

Your Walker Bay boat should be stored in a covered area when not in use to prolong the life of the boat.

12.2. Rigid Inflatable Dinghy tube. For long term or winter storage remove the tube and rinse it with a mild detergent and tap water. Store the tube in a safe, clean and dry place. To prolong the life of the tube avoid storing it in direct sunlight and contact with sharp or abrasive objects. If you store the boat with the tube attached, release some air pressure so the tube is not inflated to its maximum.

12.3. Tube repairs. Minor punctures and leaks can be repaired with the repair kit included with your boat. Follow the directions provided with the repair kit. For significant repairs contact your dealer or Walker Bay customer service.
